Methodology:

The 2023 Swiss Personal Satisfaction Study is based on a representative survey carried out by market research company Ipsos as commissioned by moneyland.ch. The survey was conducted in March 2023, and included 1538 residents across French-speaking and German-speaking Switzerland. Participants were asked to rate their personal satisfaction with various situations and institutions using a scale of 1 (completely unsatisfied) to 10 (completely satisfied). They could also choose to abstain from rating an individual point.

The ratings for 2021 are taken from the 2021 Swiss Personal Satisfaction Study published by moneyland.ch in August 2021. The 2021 survey did not include ratings for doctors. Satisfaction with telecom service providers has been replaced with satisfaction with Internet service providers in the 2023 survey. moneyland.ch did not carry out a Swiss Personal Satisfaction Study in 2022.

Results can differ from each other slightly due to rounding.
